Getting Better All the Time...

The Jaguar XJ range has undergone dramatic changes over the past three years, expanding from three to five distinct derivatives. For 2007, all XJ's are further refined with the addition of acoustic laminated side glass and a radio frequency-based tire pressure monitoring system.

The 2007 Jaguar XJ also offers available multi-media connectivity for iPod, MP3 player and DVD players, digital memory media, Playstation or Gameboy systems, with the option of 6.5-inch displays in the backs of the front seat head restraints,

and independent input points for two rear seat passengers.

The 2007 XJ continues to improve and evolve with more standardized equipment such as Bluetooth wireless technology for mobile phone on all XJ models and several upgrades to the base model XJ8 and XJ8 L — soft-grain leather trimmed seating with contrast piping, 16-way heated front seats and chrome mirror caps.

Jaguar's flagship XJ sedan broke new ground when it went on sale in 2003. For the first time ever, the complete body structure of the XJ sedan was manufactured from aluminum

alloys.

Aluminum alloy is notable for its high strength and low weight, but it isn't a new material for Jaguar. From its earliest days as a car manufacturer, Jaguar used many forms of light alloy in its vehicles and components.
